TNB and 2 subsidiaries bag CSR, environmental awards

KUALA LUMPUR: Utility giant Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) has won platinum in the CSR Leadership Award category at the Eighth Annual Global CSR Summit and Awards 2016 in Bali, Indonesia recently.

The award honours TNB chairman Tan Sri Leo Moggie's active participation in the company's corporate social responsibility (CSR) programmes in education, environ-

mental conservation and sustainability, as well as community development.

Two TNB subsidiaries also bagged awards.

"TNB's success shows the company is on the right track in promoting CSR and environmental sustainability activities in the region," said the company in a statement on Saturday.

Subsidiary TNB Research Sdn

Bhd won gold in the "Best Environmental Excellence" category for its research, environmental conservation and the relocation and rescue of wildlife in the Hulu Terengganu hydro project.

Another unit, TNB Janamanjung Sdn Bhd, garnered gold in the "Best Workplace Practices" category and silver for "Best Environmental Excellence" for its concern for workers and the environment. Bernama
