**T**HE government has activated detailed contingency plans to tackle all possible scenarios and ensure Malaysia's energy supply

remains secure under any circumstances.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said the government's focus remained steadfast — ensuring supply stability, mitigating price pressures and protecting the people from the direct impact of the energy crisis.

“Every step is implemented with full responsibility and careful consideration, with clear priority given to safeguarding the welfare of the people through targeted and effective support initiatives.

enterprises, will continue to be strengthened to ensure a holistic, balanced and high-impact approach,” he said in a Facebook post yesterday after chairing a special meeting with menteri besar and chief ministers.
