100,000 smart meters installed in Melaka

MELAKA: Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) has installed smart meters at 100,000 of the total of 340,000 households statewide.

In a media statement issued on Friday, TNB said consumers who received a notice pertaining to the installation of smart meters were encouraged to make an appointment early to facilitate the installation process at their respective homes.

This is also to ensure someone is at home during the installation. If no one is at home, the appointment will be rescheduled.

It said the installation notice would be sent by post or by hand at least 30 days before their homes were to be fitted with smart meters.

"Consumers are advised to contact TNB at 1-300-88-5454 during office hours (from 8am to 5.15pm) or visit the Kedai Tenaga during operation hours," the statement said.

Smart meters are expected to be installed in stages in other states starting next year and completed nationwide by 2022.
