KOTA KINABALU: The Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd Workers Union (KPPSESB) recently paid a courtesy call on Tenaga Nasional (TNB) President, Datuk Ir Megat Jalaluddin Bin Megat Hassan, to discuss retirement benefits, with emphasis on healthcare coverage for Sabah Electricity (SE) employees.

The six-member delegation of KPPSESB senior officers received a warm welcome from TNB senior management at their headquarters in Kuala Lumpur. They engaged in discussions to share views and suggestions for improving the welfare of SE workers.

The Union elaborated on the pressing need to ensure the protection of the welfare and medical benefits for both current employees and retirees of Sabah Electricity.

During the meeting, Megat, who is also TNB's Chief Executive Officer (CEO), expressed genuine interest in the concerns expressed by SE employees regarding the status of their medical benefits upon retirement.

The KPPSESB outlined its objectives which prioritizes the welfare of SE employees, highlighting the need to ensure medical benefits for both current and retirees. The Union strives to ensure the welfare of employees are protected not only during their tenure but also well into their retirement years.

The Union has submitted its resolutions for medical benefits, while TNB is finalizing its own medical benefits for retired personnel, which are expected to be published and implemented with SE this year. – **Mohd Izham Bin Hashim**
