Sunview bags RM1.96b RE deal from TNB Genco

Sunview bags RM1.96b RE deal from TNB Genco

KUALA LUMPUR: Sunview Group Bhd's consortium, comprising its wholly-owned subsidiary, Fabulous Sunview Sdn Bhd, and Cypark Renewable Energy Sdn Bhd, has secured a contract from TNB Power Generation Sdn Bhd (TNB Genco) for a large-scale renewable energy (RE) project worth RM1.96 billion.

Sunview said the consortium, known as 'Consortium Cre-Sunview', received a letter of acceptance (LOA) on Friday for the provision of engineering, procurement, construc-

tion and commissioning works for a 595 megawatt alternating current (MWac) floating solar photovoltaic plant, along with a battery energy storage system at Kenyir Lake, Terengganu.

Consortium Cre-Sunview is an unincorporated joint venture, in which Cypark Renewable Energy and Fabulous Sunview have 60 per cent and 40 per cent interests, respectively.

Meanwhile, TNB Genco is a wholly owned subsidiary of Tenaga Nasional Bhd.

The group said the contract value is inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, fees, and sales and service tax (SST), with construction scheduled to commence on June 2, 2026, and completion targeted for Sept 29, 2028.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the contract is expected to contribute positively to the future earnings of Sunview and its subsidiaries.

The contract would not have any effect on the share capital and substantial shareholders' shareholdings of the group. —Bernama
