## Cypark secures RM1.96b EPCC deal

## Cypark secures RM1.96b EPCC deal

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Cypark Resources Bhd has secured a RM1.96 billion engineering, procurement, construction and commissioning contract (EPCC) for a large-scale floating solar photovoltaic (PV) project with a battery energy storage system in Tasik Kenyir, Terengganu.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia, the renewable energy firm said the contract was awarded by TNB Power Generation Sdn Bhd, a unit of Tenaga Nasional Bhd, to a consortium comprising its wholly-owned

unit Cypark Renewable Energy Sdn Bhd (CRE) and Fabulous Sunview Sdn Bhd.

Cypark said CRE holds a 60 per cent stake in the unincorporated consortium, while Fabulous Sunview owns the remaining 40 per cent.

"The EPCC contract covers the engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of a 595 megawatt alternating current floating solar PV plant, together with a battery energy storage system," it said.

The project is scheduled to com-

mence on June 2, with a completion period of 850 days.

"Upon completion in 2028, the Kenyir project is set to be the largest floating solar photovoltaic development in Southeast Asia, marking a major milestone for the region and reinforcing Malaysia's leadership in large-scale clean energy infrastruc-

ture," it added.

Cypark group managing director Datuk Ami Moris said the project underscores the company's strategic push to establish itself as a leading renewable energy platform, while marking the next phase of growth backed by a robust pipeline of quality projects.
