## MCMC took down 159 false posts in 4 days

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) removed 159 false social media posts over four days, targeting misinformation tied to the ongoing global crisis.

Communications Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil said the posts fell into three main categories.

"First, false content related to fuel price hikes. Second, misinformation claiming that Malaysia would have to pay toll charges to use the Strait of Hormuz.

"Third, false claims about increases in Tenaga Nasional Bhd tariffs," he said after attending the Federal Territories PKR general meeting launch on Friday.

He said the content was removed between March 29 and April 1.

Fahmi, who is also PKR information chief, urged party members and the public to play a role in ensuring the dissemination of accurate information, especially as the country faced global economic and energy challenges.

"This is the time to spread accurate information. At the same time, channel any information to the government so that immediate action can be taken."

He added that unity was crucial as the country navigated uncertainties stemming from the global energy crisis.

"At a time when the nation is facing global energy and economic challenges, we must unite and set aside our differences."

Fahmi called on party members to provide constructive ideas and feedback to the government.

He said the National Economic Action Council met weekly to deliberate on views and proposals before taking appropriate action.
