Perak Corp inks new operational and maintenance deals, expects RM800m contribution

KUALA LUMPUR: Perak Corp Bhd's subsidiary Lumut Maritime Ter-minal Sdn Bhd (LMT) has inked three operation and maintenance (OM) agreements with Lekir Bulk Terminal Sdn Bhd (LBT), which is expected to contribute RM800 million over 26 years.

The agreements are deemed as related party transactions as LBT is an associate company of LMT, by virtue of 50% minus one share held by Pelaburan Lumut Sdn Bhd in LMT. Pelaburan Lumut also owns 80% of LBT. The first agreement is an ad-
