Most of its construction projects were awarded by the government and quasi-gov-ernment bodies. The order book for the con-struction arm stands at RM1.8 billion.





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Property development is the group's private enterprise. Its ongoing projects include Bayu 25ixty @ Kemuning Prima in Selangor. It also has an undeveloped land bank of 20 acres in the Klang Valley and Johor.
