## TNB technician dies after electric shock

TELUK INTAN: A Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) technician who suffered an electric shock here on Wednesday died yesterday morning.

The victim, Mohd Zaid Sulaiman, 34, died at Teluk Intan Hospital intensive care unit at about 8am.

His body was brought back to his home town in Kampar and laid to rest at Kuala Dipang Muslim cemetery this evening.

Mohd Zaid who suffered 80 per cent burns over his body was carrying out maintenance work at Medan Niaga Lagenda Electrical Substation, Hutan Melintang near here.

Mohd Zaid, who joined TNB in April 2002, is survived by his widow, Norlydianawati Idris Akri and two children, aged six and eight.

Meanwhile Perak TNB general manager Raja Abdul Jalil Raja Zaid in a statement said the company would continue to provide the necessary assistance to the deceased's family. - Bernama
