

TNB appoints former Kedah MB as chairman

KUALA LUMPUR: Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) has appointed Datuk Seri Mahdzir Khalid as chairman, effective May 12.

Mahdzir will succeed Tan Sri Ahmad Badri Mohd Zahir, who was appointed as Employee Provident Fund chairman on May 1, the national utility company said in a statement.

It said Mahdzir was no stranger to the national electricity industry as he was the energy, green technology and water deputy minister from May 2013 to July 2015 before being appointed as the education minister until 2018.

Mahdzir, who was Kedah chief minister from December 2005 to March 2008, holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education from Universiti Sains Malaysia and sat as chairman of Muda Agricultural Development Authority and Kedah Regional Development Authority.

He was also the Tourism Ministry's Tourism Promotion Malaysia deputy chairman.

TNB president and chief executive officer Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan welcomed the appointment and said Mahdzir has broad knowledge of the electricity industry.

"Given the current difficult period, we believe his leadership will help steer TNB through the challenges and transform it to be among the top 10 utility companies in the world by 2025.

"I would like to convey my gratitude to Ahmad Badri, who has also served as a TNB board of director, representing the Finance Ministry since Nov 1, 2018.

"His leadership, guidance, knowledge, advice and commitment have greatly benefited us," added Amir Hamzah.
