Sabah Electricity to replace faulty voltage cable in Taman Foh Sang

Sabah Electricity to replace faulty voltage cable in Taman Foh Sang

KOTA KINABALU: Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd (SESB) has identified the cause of the recent power disruption in Taman Foh Sang – a damaged low-voltage cable – and will carry out repairs, announced Chan Loong Wei, Political Secretary to the Luyang State Assemblyman.

Chan expressed gratitude to residents and business owners for their patience, acknowledgingtheinconvenience caused.

During the outage, SESB deployed two generators to mitigate disruptions in the commercial area.

He also provided updates on

key infrastructure projects, including the Luyang 33/11kV Main Distribution Substation (PPU) near Dewan Foo Chow, which is on track for completion by September. Once operational, it will significantly stabilise electricity supply across Luyang.

Additionally, another major

substation - the 33/11kV PPU Lido near Bukit Kopungit - is in the pipeline, further strengthening the area's power grid.

Chan emphasised the Luyang State Assemblyman's office and SESB's joint commitment to upgrading infrastructure to support the community's growing needs.
