Deputy menteri besar leads Kelantan award recipients

KOTA BARU: Deputy Menteri Besar Datuk Mohd Amar Nik Abdullah heads a list of 582 recipients who will be conferred awards and medals in conjunction with the sultan of Kelantan's 46th birthday celebration today.

State Secretary Datuk Mohd Faudzi Che Mamat said Sultan Muhammad V would present the awards at an investiture ceremony at Istana Balai Besar here today, which is a public holiday in the state.

He said Amar would receive the Darjah Kebesaran Jiwa Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Mulia (SJMK), which carries the title Datuk. Another recipient is Academy of Sciences Malaysia president Tan Sri Datuk Dr Ahmad Tajuddin Ali.

"The two are among 37 people who will receive the datukship," he said at Istana Balai Besar here yesterday.

The other 35 datukship recipients include Target Resources Sdn Bhd strategic planning and liaison (military) director Datuk Mamat Ariffin Abdullah, who will be given the Darjah Kebesaran Kesateria Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Perkasa (SPKK).

Three will get the Darjah Kebesaran Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (SPSK) awards — Kelantan Services Commission deputy chairman Datuk Yusoff Ismail, former police commissioner Tan Sri Mohd Zaman Khan @ Hassan Rahim Khan and Kelantan police chief Datuk Mazlan Lazim.

Three will be conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Mulia (DPMK) and they are Universiti Malaysia Kelantan vice-chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Mortaza Mohamed, director-general of the Economic Planning Unit (Prime Minister's Department) Datuk Seri Dr Rahamat Bivi Yusoff and East

Coast Economic Region Development Council chief executive officer Datuk Seri Jebasingam Issace John.

Six will be conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Jiwa Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Mulia (DJMK) and they include the ruler's cousin, Tengku Rozlynda Tengku Mohd Nasrun, Pantai Cahaya Bulan Resort manager Subramaniam Ara Nachiappan and Kelantan Red Crescent chairman Wan Ali Wan Ahmad.

Five will receive the Darjah Kebesaran Kesateria Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Perkasa (DPKK) and they include Datuk Paduka Maharaja Lela Istana Negara Datuk Wira Md Tajri Alwi, army special operations commander Major General Datuk Azmy Yahya and army Medical Department chief Brigadier General Dr Zulkeffeli Mat Jusoh.

Seventeen recipients will receive the Darjah Kebesaran Paduka Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (DPSK) and they include state education director Abdul Aziz Ab-

dullah, state Tenaga Nasional Bhd managing director Md Yuslan Md Yusof, Kelantan legal adviser Shahidani Abdul Aziz and Bank Rakyat managing director Datuk Mustafha Ab Razak.

Only one will be conferred the Darjah Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Mulia (PMK), three will get the Darjah Jiwa Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Mulia (JMK) and five will be awarded with the Kesateria Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Perkasa (PKK).

Thirty-eight people will be awarded the Darjah Kebesaran Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (PSK) and 57 will get the Darjah Kebesaran Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (BSK).

Fifty-four recipients will be conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Setia Mahkota Kelantan Yang Amat Terbilang (ASK). A total of 147 people will receive the Bintang Seri Mahkota Kelantan (SMK), Bintang Seri Kelantan (SK) and Bintang Ahli Kelantan (AK) awards.
