Firm fined RM100,000 for meter tampering

PETALING JAYA: An Electronics Manufacturing Services provider was fined RM100,000 after it was found guilty of tampering a Tenaga Nasional Berhad electricity meter which prevented it from recording actual electricity usage.

Nationgate Technology (M) Sdn Bhd was fined for two charges under Subsection 37(3)(e) of the Electricity Supply Act 1990 (Act 447), with the amount of each charge being RM50,000.

During the proceeding, six witnesses were called to testify by the prosecution led by Energy Commission prosecutor Nazzehan Farhy Nasser, whereas three witnesses were called by the defence led by Ramkarpal Singh.

The sentence was handed to the company on Jan 18 by Butterworth sessions court Judge Noor Aini Yusof.
