TNB customers get 2.5pc rebate on security deposit

KUALA LUMPUR: Customers of Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) will receive a 2.5 per cent rebate on their electricity security deposit. In a statement by TNB, the interest, as provided under the Electricity Supply Act 1990, would be credited into the January bill. "With the yearly interest, the security deposits of TNB customers will increase over time. This is because the interest is calculated based on the accumulated balance of the deposit. However, the rebate is given only to deposit paid in cash. Customers whose deposit exceed RM2,000 have the option to pay a deposit either in cash or bank guarantee," the statement read.
