TNB, PKNS to develop district cooling system

KUALA LUMPUR: Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) has partnered with Selangor State Development Corp (PKNS) to develop and operate a district cooling system in Seksyen 14, Shah Alam.

The collaboration will be undertaken through their subsidiaries, TNB Engineering Corp Sdn Bhd and PKNS FM Integrated Sdn Bhd.

In a joint statement, they said the partnership combines TNB's

engineering and energy infrastructure expertise with PKNS' asset ownership and urban development experience.

The district cooling system will supply chilled water from a centralised plant to buildings owned or managed by PKNS and its affiliates as well as tenants and lessees in the area.

These include Plaza Perangsang, Plaza Alam Sentral, SA Sentral, SACC Mall, PKNS headquar-

ters and Kompleks PKNS Shah Alam.

TNB president and chief executive officer Datuk Megat Jalaluddin Megat Hassan said the partnership underscores the company's commitment to delivering innovative energy solutions.

He said the collaboration aims to improve energy efficiency, reduce carbon emissions and contribute to the development of smarter, future-ready cities.
