KUALA BERANG: The newly launched Hybrid Hydro Floating Solar (HHFS) and Green Hydrogen Hub projects in Terengganu have the potential to attract international investors, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

He said the alternative energy initiative, a collaboration between Petroliam Nasional Bhd (Petronas) and Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB), aligned with Malaysia's energy policy and international aspirations for green
