BMW delivers fleet of 5 Series Hybrid cars for Cepsi 2018

KUALALUMPUR: BMW Malaysia Sdn Bhd yesterday handed over a fleet of BMW 5 Series Hybrid to Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) to be utilised at the upcoming Conference of the Electric Power Supply Industry (Cepsi) 2018.

The fleet will be used as the official cars at the conference, taking place from Sept 17 to 22, for which BMW Malaysia is the official e-mobility partner.
