TNB bags RM705 mil maintenance contract from Kuwaiti govt

KUALA LUMPUR (April 15): Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) (KL:TENAGA), via its wholly owned subsidiary TNB Repair and Maintenance Sdn Bhd (TNB REMACO), has secured a RM705 million contract from the Kuwait Ministry of Electricity, Water, and Renewable Energy for maintenance works at the Sabiya Power Generation and Water Distillation Plant in Kuwait. The seven-year contract, awarded through a joint venture with Kuwait-based Al Dhow Engineering, will cover maintenance, repair, and overhaul services for the facility located 65km from Kuwait City. The plant houses four oil- and gas-powered units with a total generation capacity of 299.4 megawatts, playing a key role in Kuwait's national energy supply. — *theedgemalaysia.com*
