Power fully restored in Johor, Malacca, Kelantan

AS OF 10am yesterday, power supply was fully restored in Johor, Malacca and Kelantan, and no consumer account has been affected. According to a Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) statement in Kuala Lumpur yesterday, electrical supplies in Pahang and Terengganu, however, have yet to become fully operational. He said 60 electrical sub-stations in Pahang involving 1,890 consumer accounts were shut down, while 90 sub-stations were shut down in Terengganu, pertaining to 3,328 consumer accounts. In Pahang, the areas involved are Kuantan (37 sub-stations), Triang (11), Pekan (six), Temerloh (four), and one each in Maran and Jerantut. The statement said 26 sets of power generators were sent to Kuantan and four sets to Jerantut. — *Bernama*
