SOME 200 pupils in Hulu Perak, Perak recently received school necessities under Tenaga Nasional Bhd's (TNB) "Back To School" programme.

The pupils from five schools each got a kit consisting of school uniform, bag and stationery.

The schools are SK Bongor, SK Sungai Tiang, SK Basia Lama, SK Sauk and SK Chegar Galah.
