RIME Minister Datuk Seri RIME Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim com-mended Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) for its achieve-ments and initiatives in renew-able energy during the launch of TNB's Eastfield and Bunkers Hill solar farms in the United King-dom.

Celebrating the milestone at the Royal Lancaster Hotel in London, Anwar said: "This is not just pure investment, but an opportunity for us to learn and share expe-rience in alternative renewable energy; solar and wind, that would be critical for TNB to em-bark on this exercise in Malaysia." TNB's Bunkers Hill in Rother-

wick (66.7MWp) and Eastfield in Harbury (35MWp) are two cut-ting-edge solar farms which are expected to deliver a combined capacity of 102MW to the whole country.

This venture showcases Malaysia's expertise in driving sustainable energy solutions worldwide.

Anwar said: "TNB is one of the major players in the country. It has done remarkably well. It has

"We are part of the region which is dynamic in terms of its growth. The focus is on effective-ness of investments in Malaysia and, therefore, TNB and other re-lated players have been entrusted with this responsibility to con-duct research to explore new av-enues particularly in renewable energy.² energy.

Anwar reiterated that the role of TNB is critical in ensuring that Malaysia honors its commitment (as chair of Asean) to renewable energy. "As such, I must take this op-

portunity to thank TNB because they have the roadmap (to achieve this)."

Anwar added that new technology energy demands new person-nel and training, and he applauded TNB's continued efforts in training students and placing im-portance on research.
