Terengganu on treble mission, but Tenaga won't switch off power

PETALING JAYA: Terengganu are bent on an unprecedented treble but Tenaga Nasional are not about to end the Malaysian Hockey League (MHL) empty-handed after their logic-defying escape to reach the TNB Cup final. Tenaga snatched victory from the

Tenaga snatched victory from the jaws of defeat when they came back from a 0-3 deficit against Maybank in the semi-finals on Thursday to score three goals in the last three minutes and eventually win the shootout 3-0 to contest the final at the National Hockey Stadium in

should so to briest the final at the National Hockey Stadium in Bukit Jalil today. Such heroics were never wit-nessed in recent times in the MHL but Tenaga captain Syed Syafig Syed Mohd Cholan said the magical win has spurred on the belief that anything is possible in the Cup final which they will be defending. Maybank had one foot in the final after goals from Razie Rahim (sec-ond and 22nd minutes) and Ashran Hamsani (42nd). However, Azril Misron's 57th min-ute field goal and a double from youngster Amirul Haniff Mamat in the 59th and the dying seconds of the full-time (60th) forced the shootout.

Speedy Tigers Firhan Ashaari, Shahril Saabah and Azrai Aizad Abu Kamal slotted in coolly while Maybank's Izham Azhar, Shahmie Irfan Suhaimi and Syawal Abdul Razak all missed the shootout.

To ensure the team retain the TMB Cup, Syafiq will be playing although he is still troubled by a left hand (metacarpal) injury that need-ed surgery three weeks ago. "Tm not fully healed but I want to play and help the team to win the TMB Cup. We have the chance and the team spirit has brought me back to battle for the title," said Syafiq. "I didn't want my absence to put a havy burden on my teammates and I want to do my part. Tenaga coach Norsaiful Saimi was satirical as he said that the only way to beat Terenganu was by locking their influential penalty corner spe-cialist jang Jong-hyun in his hotel room before the final today. "Jang is their key. I think we prob-ably have to lock in his room so that he doesn't play the final. That's how souch is. "We have fought so hard and had to deal with so many injuries and
