IT was a stroll in the park for tabletoppers Universiti Kuala Lumpur (UniKL) when they beat TNB Thunderbolts 4-0 in a Malaysia Hockey League Premier Division tie at the KLHA Stadium yesterday.

And double champions Terengganu Hockey Team (THT) also had an easy game when they beat Tunku Mahkota Ismail Sports School (SST-MI) 7-0.

It was UniKL's third consecutive win in as many matches.
