TNB whip China team to book place in the semi-finals, Terengganu also go through

PETALING JAYA: Tenaga zapped hapless Liaoning to stay on track to deny arch rivals Terengganu's treble title bid in the

Malaysian Hockey League. Yesterday, they whipped the China team 8-2 in the quarter-finals of the TNB Cup at the Education Ministry Stadium, for a place in the semis.

Head coach Norsaiful Zaini said getting past a rather lacklustre Liaoning was easy but playing the more experienced Mayback in the semi-final tomorrow will be a challenge.

"We knew we could win big against Liaoning as it was our third meeting. So it was easy but will be totally different against Maybank in the semis.

"Maybank are much more experienced and know how to play semi-final matches. We need to maintain our performance and not make mistakes," said Norsaiful. Maybank made it to the semi-finals after

defeating UiTM 2-0 yesterday at the Tun Razak Stadium.

During the quarter-final match, ace strik-er Azrai Aizad Abu Kamal was the hero for Tenaga, scoring five goals with three coming in quick succession at the start of the match.

Azrai scored in the 1st, 5th, 7th, 33rd, and 37th minute, while Haris Iskandar scored two (27th and 40th) and Syed Mohd Syafiq Syed Cholan scored the final goal in the 52nd minute.
