Rohas unit bags RM250m jobs

KUALA LUMPUR: Rohas Tecnic Bhd's (RTB) 75-owned subsidiary, HG Power Transmission Sdn Bhd (HGPT), has been awarded two contracts by Tenaga Nasional Bhd, worth RM249.63mil, for the supply and installation of transmission lines.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia yesterday, RTB said the first contract, valued at RM126.85mil, involved the supply and installation of 31.8km of 500 KV double circuit transmission line and 22.3km of 275 kv double circuit transmission line on turnkey basis.

Meanwhile, the second contract, worth RM122.78mil, entailed the supply and installation of 31.9km of 500 KV double circuit transmission line and 32km of 275 KV double circuit transmission line on turnkey basis, it said.

The lines, which would be installed from PMU Bentong South to PMU Lenggeng and from PMU Lenggeng to PMU Mahkota Cheras, are to be completed within 723 days.

"The projects will not have any material impact on RTB group's results for the quarter ending March 31, 2018, but is expected to contribute positively in the future," it added. — Bernama
