

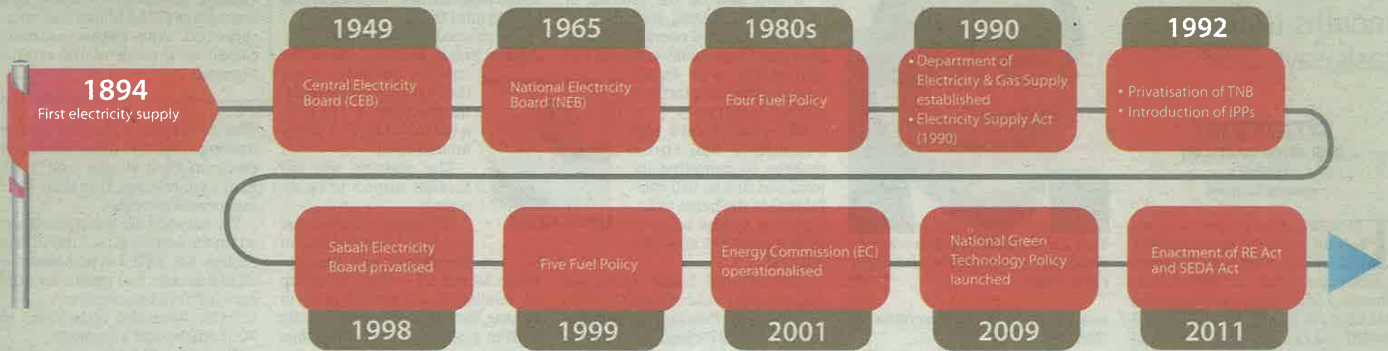


# LIGHTING UP MALAYSIA SINCE 1949

As we commemorate Malaysia Day, we also celebrate the achievements of bringing electricity to the nation. The journey started in 1894 when the first electricity supply was generated. It was followed by the formation of the country's first utility body in 1949 generating 39.8 MW with 45,000 customers and less than 10 percent electrification.

Now the nation has grown to an installed capacity (what we can generate) to 21,060 MW, 8.5 million customers or an electrification of 99.8 percent. As we move forward, the government and its electricity provider will continue to improve and expand electrification reach in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak including the rural area electrification programmes.

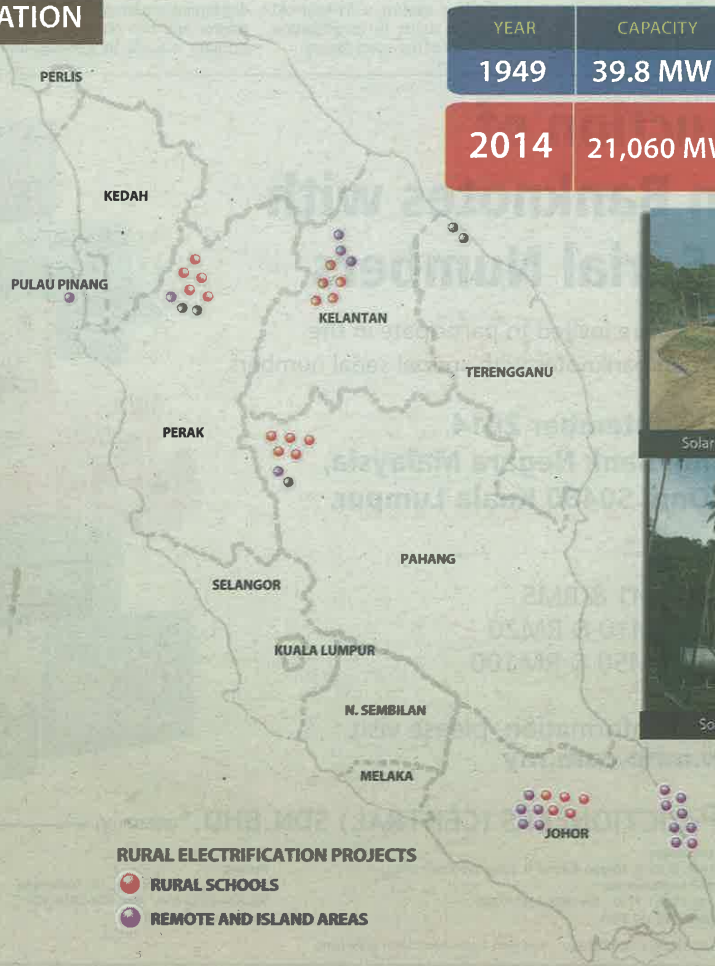
