KUALA LUMPUR: Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) will continue to provide its services throughout the Movement Control Order (MCO) period, by ensuring smooth operation of its power stations, said TNB chief corporate officer Datuk Wira Roslan Ab Rahman. “Apart from power generation, other TNB technical teams directly involved in critical services category will continue to work to make sure all customers receive uninterrupted and stable electricity supply,” he said, adding that they comprised technical employees in the grid and distribution network, as well as restoration and reconnection works. Other critical services operating as usual include TNB CareLine customer services, security services and mobile generator facilities.
