TNB has always been committed to prioritising the stability and reliability of electricity supply to hospitals, vaccine storage centres (PSV) and vaccination centres, as well as temporary police and military security posts. Since the Movement Control Order 1.0 in March last year, TNB has contributed more than RM33m towards this purpose and is now focusing on ensuring electricity supply at more than 40 PSVs and more than 400 PPVs remains stable.
