# NO POWER DISRUPTION AT KLIA, SAYS TNB

It is ready to assist probe into airport baggage handling system breakdown

#### KUALA LUMPUR

**T**HE power supply system at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) was in good condition when the baggage handling system broke down on Saturday, said Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB).

The company said no supply disruptions were recorded on the day of the incident.

“TNB is ready to cooperate with the relevant quarters to assist in further investigations, as well as support any mitigation measures and subsequent improvements.”

It added that consumers wishing to report any electricity supply interruptions could do so via the 15454 hotline, private message on Facebook via TNB Careline’s page, direct message to @Tenaga\_Nasional on X, or email CareLine@myTNB.my.

Last Saturday, the baggage handling system at KLIA’s Terminal 1 temporarily went offline, causing delays of two to four hours for many passengers.

The Transport Ministry said on

Monday it had identified the root cause and had taken steps to prevent a recurrence and strengthen system resilience.

It has mandated a comprehensive overhaul of the airport’s baggage-handling protocols and infrastructure.

The ministry will also table a cabinet note regarding the incident today.

The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia is investigating the issue.
