JOINT VENTURE WITH AL DHOW ENGINEERING

TNB Remaco expands power plant maintenance business in Kuwait

KUALA LUMPUR: TNB Repair and Maintenance Sdn Bhd (TNB Remaco) has partnered with Kuwait-based Al Dhow Engineering to expand its power plant maintenance business in Kuwait.

The joint-venture has signed a long-term service agreement with General Electric Global Services to provide maintenance service solutions for the gas turbines at Shuaiba North Power Generation and Water Distillation Plant in Al Ahmadi, Kuwait.

The plant is owned by Kuwait's Electricity, Water and Renewable Energy Ministry.

The agreement is part of a broader effort by the ministry to modernise the power generation infrastructure in Kuwait, contributing to the global effort for a sustainable energy transition.

The long-term service agreement was announced during United Nations Climate Change Conference in Dubai.

The scope of the contract includes upgrading the gas tur-



bine's combustion system and the provision of technical advisory services for any plant-related issues or the required upgrades.

TNB Remaco chairman Muhammad Nazri Pazil said it also has four other maintenance projects at various power plants in Kuwait.

"Kuwait is one of our biggest international markets, besides Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, Cambodia and Vietnam," he added.

TNB Remaco is a wholly owned subsidiary of Tenaga Nasional Bhd's power generation arm, TNB Power Generation Sdn Bhd. It specialises in operation and maintenance, emphasising on power plants such as gas, steam and hydro turbines, boiler, generator and others.
