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Sabah Electricity upgrading 132kV Segaliud-Dam Road transmission line.

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KOTA KINABALU: Sabah Electricity is in the final stages of upgrading the 132kV Segaliud-Dam Road transmission line to a higher voltage of 275kV.

This project, set to be commissioned in mid-April 2025, will significantly enhance energy transmission capacity from 200MW to 400MW daily, facilitating more efficient power transfer from Sabah's West Coast to the East Coast.

The upgrade will also reduce reliance on costly diesel and MFO-based generation sources, which currently require substantial government subsidies.

Sabah Electricity Chief Executive Officer, Mohd Yaakob Jaafar, stated that the final upgrade works are underway from March 22 to March 29, 2025.

"Our goal is to complete the project before Hari Raya Aidilfitri to ensure uninterrupted and stable power supply during the festive season, meeting the increased demand," he said in a statement on Saturday.
