## River Blue Kuala Selangor come from behind to upset fancied opponents in hockey final

RIVER Blue Kuala Selangor put up a gutsy display to emerge Division Three champions in the TNB-QNET Selangor Hockey League (SHL). River Blue Kuala Selangor came from a goal down to defeat IIUM Mustang 4-1 in the final at the Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) Hockey Stadium Stadium.

It was a dramatic end to the match as River Blue Kuala Selangor's goals came in the last 10 minutes of the game.
