No electricity for 63,000 in Pahang

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 1,072 electrical substations in several districts in Pahang have been hit by floods, forcing Tenaga Nasional Berhad to cease supply to 62,907 consumers as of noon yesterday. The affected substations are in Kuantan/Gebeng, Rompin, Maran, Pekan, Kuala Lipis and Jerantut. A statement from TNB in Terengganu said the main entry substation in Geliga, Kemaman was also shut down for safety as of noon yesterday, adding that 141 substations had been shut down, affecting 5,272 consumers in the state.
