GLOBAL COVID-19 CASES



Updates: 57,521 patients are currently infected with the virus. More than 54,000 are in mild condition while 3,489 are in serious or critical condition. Covid-19 has killed 37 doctors. The country has imposed new strict penalties, including imprisonment for those tested positive and not staying at home.



Updates: The U.S. Senate on Wednesday unanimously backed a US\$2 trillion bill aimed at helping unemployed workers and industries hurt by the coronavirus pandemic, as well as providing billions of dollars to buy urgently-needed medical equipment.



Updates: China reported no new Covid-19 infections for two consecutive days, but the number of imported cases spiked to 67 in just a day. The virus's epicentres in Hubei province and its capital, Wuhan, reported zero cases, but the death toll was on a rise.



Updates: Spain, which has recorded more deaths than China, has extended its state of emergency for another 15 days until Apr 12. People are confined to their homes and only allowed to leave to buy essential items. A skating rink in Madrid has been turned into a makeshift morgue. The government has ordered masks, gloves and testing kits from China.



Updates: The country is on a three-week nationwide lockdown when the number of infections hit the 500 mark. Non-essential businesses have been banned and the people are told to stay home, with anyone flouting the law risks being fined and even jailed. The government announced that rice would be available to 800 million of India's poor at a subsidised rate.



Updates: A 21-year-old woman, believed to be the youngest person with no pre-existing health conditions, was reported to have died from Covid-19 last week. Researchers from the Brunel University London, Lancaster University and the University of Surrey have developed a low cost test kit that can detect Covid-19 within 30 minutes using a handheld hardware.



Updates: Russian government announced the halting of all international flights starting today. Exceptions will be made for flights bringing Russians home from abroad.



Updates: Schools in Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia will be pupil-free from March 30 onwards. Plans for online learning are afoot for the next term for all Australian schools. An additional 15,000 people were thrown out of work due to the coronavirus crisis.



Updates: The first Covid-19 related death was reported in the northeast state of Pernambuco. It was reported that the victim was an 85-year-old man from Recife, who has a medical history of diabetes, high blood pressure and coronary heart disease.
