Norsaiful urges Tenaga to channel all energy into completing treble

PETALING JAYA: Tenaga Nasional coach Norsaiful Zaini has called on his players to go all out to win the TNB Cup and complete their first ever treble.

Tenaga captured the league title in style after thumping JM Antbees 22-1 in their last Malaysian Hockey League (MHL) match on Tuesday.

The victory ended Tenaga's 21-year wait for the title and added to the Charity Cup triumph on Feb 7 after the team beat Terengganu 3-1 in a penalty shootout after a 2-2 draw in regulation time.

Tenaga now have a glorious opportunity to win the treble and Norsaiful

wants total commitment from his players to achieve the target.

Tenaga will face KL City in the first leg of the TNB Cup quarter-finals at the National Hockey Stadium in Bukit Jalil tomorrow.

"I can say that we have a complete set of players and this is a big opportunity for us. This is our best chance to win the treble," said Norsaiful.

"Although we will be playing against an inexperienced KL City side in the TNB Cup quarter-finals, we take all the games seriously and will stick to our plan.

"There is no such thing as relaxing in a match and we don't have place for players with that kind of mindset.

Everyone should give their maximum.

"The quarter-finals and semi-finals will played over two legs and we have to stay focused on our objective of winning the treble," added Norsaiful.

South Korean Jang Jong-hyun will again be Tenaga's biggest threat.

Jong-hyun is on fiery form, having scored 20 goals in just 10 games in the league.

The South Korean is likely to be the only foreign player included in the team next season.

"Tenaga have always developed and utilised local players in the MHL and we have a strong team with a lot of players who have returned," said Norsaiful.
