Steel Hawk secures RM41.3m TNB- related contracts

Steel Hawk secures RM41.3m TNB-related contracts

KUALA LUMPUR: Steel Hawk Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary, Steel Hawk Engineering Sdn Bhd (SHESB), has bagged four contracts worth a total of RM41.3 million for electrical infrastructure works related to Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB).

The works include underground cabling as well as substation construction and upgrading works in Perak and Pahang.

Steel Hawk said SHESB received the let-

ters of award this week, dated Jan 28, 2026, from Ibrahim & Sons Engineering Sdn Bhd (IBSE).

"The contracts are expected to contribute positively to the earnings of Steel Hawk Group for the financial year ending Dec 31, 2026," it said in a stock exchange filing.

According to the filing, the contracts comprised two projects for the installation of 33 kilovolt (kV) and 11kV aluminium

XLPE underground cables and accessories.

The remaining two projects involve the construction of main intake substations and related buildings for TNB, with durations ranging from about nine months to two years.

Steel Hawk said the contracts are not expected to expose the company to any distinctly new risks, as it is already actively involved in similar services within the Steel Hawk Group.
