"As a result, the Dual Sim Router project has successfully helped TNB to achieve a world-class system average interruption duration index or SAIDI to 44.95 minutes in Financial Year 2020," added Fazil. For the record, TNB's SAIDI figure for 2019 was 48.13 minutes.
