He succeeds Datuk Ir. Megat Jalaluddin bin Megat Hassan, who completed his tenure on 28 February 2026 after serving as President and CEO since March 2024.

Datuk Ir. Ts. Shamsul currently serves as TNB's Chief Regulatory and Stakeholder Management Officer, where he has played a pivotal role in shaping the industry's regulatory landscape and strengthening stakeholder confidence in support of TNB's long-term aspirations. With more than 37 years of service in TNB, he brings extensive leadership experience across multiple portfolios.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from North Carolina A&T State University, USA, and a Master of Business Administration from Universiti Tenaga Nasional.
