JMFR is a fellowship fun ride with dedicated water stations located at Pasir Salak Resort, Changkat Cermin and Seri Manjung. TNB has been organising JMFR since 2008 to promote wellness through cycling. The event, held in line with TNB's efforts to preserve the environment for future generation, gives participants the opportunity to enjoy the beautiful sceneries of Perak.

Similar to the previous JMFR, TNB will ensure adherence to top-notch safety features in this year's event. As such, the cyclists will be accompanied by 100 marshals, 40 local police officers, as well as adequate number of support cars and ambulances.

Due to JMFR's growing popularity among local and international cyclists, each time it is held, Janamanjung saw a sudden influx of visitors who came as participants and supporters.
