Around 150 companies will showcase their leading technologies, products and services at the 22nd Conference of The Electric Power Supply Industry (CEPSI 2018), East Asia and the Western Pacific's most prominent and prestigious electricity supply industry conference cum exhibition.

Half of the exhibitors are Malaysian companies involve in the electricity supply industry, said TNB Chief Corporate Officer and AESIEAP 2017/2018 Secretary General, Datuk Wira Roslan Ab Rahman.

The remaining are from China PR, Japan, Singapore, Indonesia, Australia, France, Germany, India, Ireland, South Korea, Portugal, Chinese Taipei, the United Kingdom and the United States.
